Planting of Trees in Limited Common Areas

As was recently communicated in the September homeowner letter, the planting of trees in limited common areas can be a hazard to persons and property. While the planting of trees is not prohibited, it is the owner's responsibility to keep trees properly trimmed and maintained.

In the next few days, Foxboro's Community Manager will be making notes of which trees need to be trimmed during weekly property inspections. Letters will be sent to those homeowners who need to address the maintenance of their trees.

Per the Foxboro Rules and Regulations: Section 3.20, Exhibit B, item (i), driving at speeds in excess of 15 MPH is prohibited.
